

Langley in Gospel Church



Gospel Church, located in Vancouver, is a member of the Korean Methodist Church of Christianity. The first pastor, Chang-Seok Ko and Dong-hee Shin, started their first service on July 5, 2015 at Riverside Calvary chapel in Langley, 96Ave, 20178.

We started with the common theme, “Community to preach the gospel of God's kingdom”. Efforts to spread the Gospel, was made possible by holding tax seminars in local communities and children camps in cooperation with local churches, and relief ministry.

In June 2020, the first Pastor Chang-Seok Ko was invited to the Toronto Methodist Church and continues to minister at the church there. Currently, the second Pastor Kang-Bae Lee was appointed as the senior minister at the Gospel Church in June 2020 to continue their ministry.

Before I was appointed, Gospel Church was established as a member of the Methodist Church, and after the appointment of Pastor Kang-bae Lee, it was changed to a member of the Presbyterian Church. As for worship services, face-to-face worship is not possible due to ongoing restrictions from Covid-19, so we currently hold worship services online.

Our church service: Sunday service PM 2:00, Wednesday service PM 8:00 Regular worship and nurturing: encouragement to continue living as a worshiper in life through one-on-one Bible study, QT ministry for all church members, and Bible reading ministry.



Even if you look at Vancouver, you see more Korean-Canadian churches than a few years ago. Obviously, the number of churches has increased as much as the number of Koreans is increasing.

Some of the people I met said, “Why are there so many churches? In the meantime, I'm starting a church again!”

It is clear that there are many churches in this land, but there aren't many churches that can love and embrace real souls, church-like churches, pastor-like pastors, and saints-like saints.

We don't have a finely crafted program, a nurturing system, or enough finances, but I have a burning passion and a dream in my heart.
